Notes concerning the full academic transcript

1. This document is the official academic record of modules taken by the student named overleaf whilst registered at the University of Leicester on the programme named overleaf.
2. Full-time undergraduate students normally take 120 credits of modules in a year. A three-year full-time undergraduate degree programme therefore consists of 360 credits. A four-year integrated Master's degree programme consists of 480 credits. A Diploma of Higher Education and a Foundation degree each consist of 240 credits. A Certificate of Higher Education consists of 120 credits. Full-time postgraduate students normally take 180 credits of modules in a year. A Master's degree consists of 180 credits, a Postgraduate Diploma of 120 credits and a Postgraduate Certificate of 60 credits.
3. The first two letters of a module code are used to indicate a module's subject area. A full list of subject areas with their codes are available at: le.ac.uk/graduation/what-is-graduation/transcript
4. Most modules will have a mark (0-100) and grade. Modules with a mark of * indicates pass or fail grading only (no numerical value given). A module grade of P = Pass. A full list of the grades available and their meaning is available at: le.ac.uk/graduation/what-is-graduation/transcript
