

WASTE DISPOSAL AND BURIAL POLICY

Poltava State Agrarian University (hereinafter referred to as PSAU) recognizes the importance of environmental responsibility and sustainable waste management. This policy is aimed at reducing negative environmental impact, developing a culture of environmental awareness, and implementing an effective waste management system.

Scale:

This policy applies to all persons on university property, including students, employees, visitors, and contractors.

Definition:

1. **Waste:** any material, substance or object that is not reused and is subject to disposal or landfill.
2. **Disposal:** the process of recycling, reusing or environmentally friendly destruction of waste.
3. **Landfill:** the final disposal of waste in specially designated landfills.

Basic principles of the policy:

1. Measuring the amount of waste generated within the university.
2. Sorting waste by categories: organic, plastic, paper, glass, hazardous.
3. Prioritizing recycling and reuse of materials.
4. Landfill – only as a last resort.
5. Providing appropriate infrastructure for waste collection and treatment.
6. Conducting information campaigns on environmentally friendly behavior.

Implementation:

1. Responsibility for implementing the policy lies with the Environmental Department of the University of Pennsylvania.
2. The University provides funding, personnel, and technical resources to support the policy.
3. The policy is reviewed annually and updated as needed.

Commitment:

At PSAU, we strive to create a safe, clean, and environmentally responsible environment. We believe that every member of the university community should play an active role in preserving the environment. This policy is the basis for creating a culture of sustainable development within the university.
