The Organizing Committee invites **academic and teaching staff, young researchers, and higher education students** to participate in the conference.

The aim of the conference is to discuss current issues in the representation of the national-linguistic worldview; the linguocultural, linguocognitive, ethnolinguistic, sociocultural, and literary aspects of intercultural communication; the theory and practice of translation as a means of intercultural communication; and innovative technologies for organizing the educational process in the context of intercultural communication.

Form of participation: offline, online.

Working languages of the conference: Ukrainian, English, German.

Conference outcomes: conference proceedings in PDF format; electronic certificate of participation (will be sent by e-mail on **November 16**).

Participation in the conference is free of charge.

THEMATIC AREAS OF THE CONFERENCE

1. National language worldviews: verbal and non-verbal representation
2. Dialogue of national cultures: linguocultural, linguistic and cognitive, ethnolinguistic and literary aspects
3. Translation in the context of intercultural communication: theory and practice
4. Innovative technologies in teaching Ukrainian and foreign languages, Ukrainian and foreign literature

TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONFERENCE, IT IS REQUIRED TO:

- 1) By **October 4**, complete the online application form at <https://surl.li/jgheqd> and attach your **abstract** in *docx format (2-4 pages), either individually or co-authored (2-3 persons), in accordance with the requirements. Example of file name: **2_Ivanenko.L.M.docx** (2 - thematic area number). Abstracts of first-level (bachelor's) and second-level (master's) students are accepted only if co-authored with their academic supervisor.
- 2) On **October 15 at 13:00** Kyiv time, participate in the plenary session: offline - at Poltava State Agrarian University; online - via Zoom. Registered participants will receive the link to the plenary session in the conference program the day before.

Requirements for abstract formatting

Page format: A4, portrait orientation, all margins 2 cm.

Text: type the text in Microsoft Word *docx format; font - Times New Roman, size 14, line spacing - 1.5, paragraph indent - 1.25 cm; no word splitting or macros; hyphens (-) and dashes (-) must be distinguished; use

quotation marks in the format «». Italic text may be used for emphasis. Do not number the pages.

Sequence of components of abstracts:

- 1) Title of the abstract - centered, in uppercase, bold font;
- 2) **Information about the author(s)** (right-aligned, single-spaced): surname and first name, position, educational institution/place of work, academic degree, academic title; **for first- and second-level higher education students:** surname and first name, course, level of higher education, name of specialty and specialization, educational institution; surname and first name of the scientific supervisor, position, educational institution/place of work, academic degree, academic title; **for third-level higher education students:** surname and first name, course, level of higher education, name of specialty, educational institution;
- 3) Text of the abstract;
- 4) Sources and literature - centered, bold font, **in alphabetical order** (single-spaced), according to the current standard of bibliographic description (DSTU 8302:2015). **Bibliographic references** should be given as: [1, p. 4], [4, p. 55; 10, p. 15], [7, pp. 14-26], [6], [3; 7; 8].
- 5) **Tables** and other non-text objects must be numbered and placed centered in the text.

Attention! The Organizing Committee reserves the right to include abstracts in the conference program, reject abstracts that do not meet the specified requirements, do not correspond to the scientific focus of the conference, or are submitted after the deadline.

The text of the publication must be edited. All abstracts will be checked for plagiarism using the certified online service (the originality level should be **at least 65%**). Responsibility for the accuracy of facts, references, and proper names rests with the author(s) of the article and the scientific supervisor (for higher education students). Abstracts will be published in the author's original version.
