You are open to learning a new language and facing interesting challenges? This offer is for you!

We are offering a Company-Sponsored Master's degree in apprenticeship with a major French International Seed Company

Successful candidates will

- Spend 2,5 years in France 6 months of French from February 2018 to August 2018. Then 2 years of the program.
- Receive high level training in plant breeding and managerial competencies and learn a new language (French)
- have most expenses (study, internship, travel, tuition, insurance) costs covered
- study half time at ESA and work half time in the company with a tutor
- successful graduates earn a Master of Science and Engineering degree from Ecole Supérieure d'Agricultures Angers Loire (ESA)

You will work as a Project manager in Ukraine and French and Ukrainian will be the working languages.

Requirements:

Candidates must have:

- a minimum of four years of Higher Education (completed and graduated) in Agronomy, Crop Science, Plant science or Plant protection.
- a strong motivation for a career in industry and especially in plant breeding
- a good acknowledgement in agronomy and basics in statistics.
- a good level of English
- a real capacity to adapt yourself to both comfortable and tough working conditions (office, field work)
- PLEASE NOTE: NO FRENCH REQUIRED TO APPLY

You must be under 26 years old on September 1st 2018 to apply.

Deadline: November 30th 2017. Only fully completed application files will be examined.

The selection process is in two steps. ESA will examine your application and will contact you for a first interview in English and/or French by one of their team. If ESA decides you are a solid candidate we will pass your file on to the company.

ESA will arrange company interviews beginning of December 2017 (or April 2018 for French speakers). The company makes the final choice. The program begins in early January 2018 for those who need French lessons and late August 2018 for French speakers.
