Requirements:

- a strong motivation for a career in industry - and especially in Food production
- a desire to learn new cultures and a new language (French)
- a real capacity to overcome challenges and to develop new competencies
- an experience abroad would be appreciated
- a good level in English (B1)
- **PLEASE NOTE: NO FRENCH REQUIRED TO APPLY**

You must be under 26 on September 1st 2018 to apply.

Deadline: December 20th 2017. Only fully completed application files will be examined.

The selection process is in two steps. ESA will examine your application and will contact you for a first interview in English by one of their team. If ESA decides you are a solid candidate we will pass your file on to the company.

ESA will arrange company interviews in Ukraine in February 2018. The company makes the final choice. The program begins in March 2018 for those who need French lessons and late August 2018 for French speakers.
